



Volunteer Role Profile: Bandstand Team

We are excited to bring back the Bandstand for New Wine Festival 2025. Located in the central area of the site, close to the Food and Fun Zones, the concept behind the Bandstand is to provide a space for charity partners to share more about the work of their organisations. It will also be a place for the New Wine family to share whether this be through an acoustic set, some pre-celebration worship or through testimony. Delegates have been invited to audition to perform here so this will be pre-planned rather than an open-mic type setup. The vision is for a relaxed space where delegates can grab a drink, pull up a deck chair and be encouraged by word and worship from both outside and within the New Wine community.

We are looking for some friendly volunteers with some PA experience to join the Bandstand Team at New Wine Festival. You will be part of a small team to daily welcome musicians, artists and partners to the Bandstand and help them get setup. There will also be a simple sound system to operate. We're looking for people who are happy to think on their feet and happy to act quickly when plans change, particularly in the case of poor weather or if musicians, artists or partners don't arrive on time or go over their allocated time.

The current Bandstand timetable outline for each day is as follows, although please be aware this is subject to change.

Daily Timetable Outline – Subject to Change

12:00 - 13:00: Musician/Band
14:00 - 14:30: 'Take a Stand' Charity Partner Slot
14:30 - 15:00: 'Take a Stand' Charity Partner Slot
15:30 - 16:30: Worship Musician/Band

Purpose of Role:

To work closely with the Partnership Support Team Leaders and the rest of the Bandstand team to support in the daily running of the Bandstand.

Key Responsibilities:

- To complete any mandatory training and team calls pre-event when required.
- Arrive on team arrival day, meet with the Team Leaders and participate in the Team Commissioning
- To operate a simple PA system.
- Help to set up the Bandstand on delegate arrival day, including, but not limited to, setting out furniture and attaching the sponsors/partners branding if required.
- To welcome musicians, artists and partners to the Bandstand.
- Ensure the timetable runs to schedule and musicians and/or partners are ready for their allotted time slot.
- To be easily contactable on site with the ability to use WhatsApp.
- To report any technical or electrical issues to the Partnership Support Team Leaders

- Keep the Bandstand area tidy at all times.
- Be prepared to help with ad-hoc tasks should they arise.

Personal Specification:

- Punctual and reliable – Ability to commit to your scheduled shifts through the event.
- Calm, resilient under pressure and can show initiative when required.
- Positive and helpful with a “can-do” attitude.
- Servant-hearted.
- Strong interpersonal skills – A welcoming and friendly attitude.
- Friendly and approachable whilst demonstrating strong communication skills particularly when liaising with partners, exhibitors and other team members.
- Team players who are able to serve with others and to support fellow team members.
- Supportive of New Wine’s aims and objectives and ability to embody these whilst serving.
- Understand the need to make New Wine Festival a fruitful experience for musicians, artists, partners and delegates.
- Able to cope with being outside in different weather conditions as well as being on their feet for quite long periods.
- Able to take direction from Partnership Support Team Leaders and the New Wine staff team.
